North of W 3rd to Lakeside

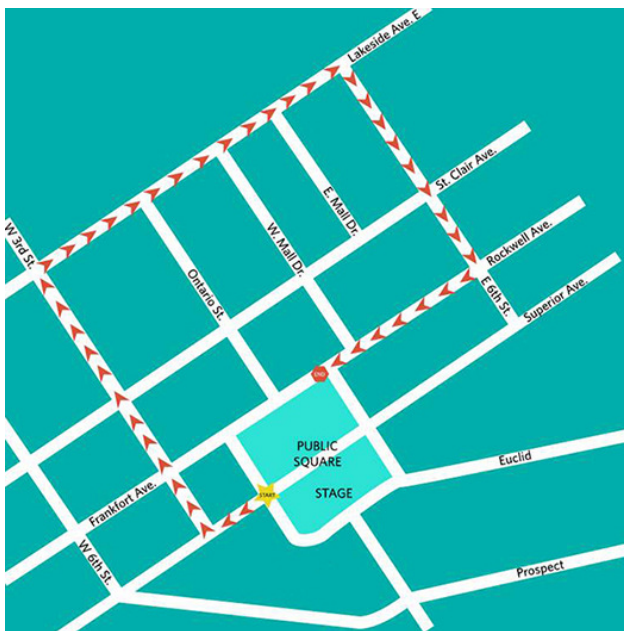
East of Lakeside to E 6th

At March for Science Cleveland, we promote the use of public transportation whenever possible. Please check with the RTA public transit for your public transportation options: riderta.com.

Note: RTA's Blue and Green lines will not be operational; however, you have the following options:

- Take bus 14 on Van Aken/Warrensville station or along Chagrin Boulevard to downtown.
- Drive to Shaker Square (remember it is market day) and take bus 11 to downtown.
- Drive to University Circle and take either the Red line or the Euclid Corridor bus.

Several thousand parking spots should be available within a few blocks of Public Square at prices ranging from \$4.00 to \$20.00, with most costing \$8.00 - \$10.00 for all day. There is a possibility that some lots may opt to charge "special event" rates, but if that happens, less expensive rates should be available further away from the square.
