Euclid Beach Park Grand Carousel Rules of the Ride

- · All riders must be at least 42 inches tall to ride alone.
- Each rider under 42 inches tall must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older.
- · Supervising adults of children under 42 inches must stand next to the figure and hold on to the child.
- · Only one rider per figure allowed.
- · No changing figures once the ride has started.
- · Please remain seated once the ride has started.
- · No horseplay on the carousel.
- No side saddle riding allowed.
- · No food or drink allowed on the carousel.
- · No bare feet, wet clothing or snow pants allowed on the carousel.
- The ride operator has the right to stop the ride at any time for the safety of the riders.
- · No backpacks on the carousel

The last Carousel ride will take place 15 minutes before closing time.


