Cleveland Sign
 • Continue to manage photo op and promote on social media

Villa Angela
 • Continue to monitor beach and swimming conditions. Expand sills as needed
 • Designate natural surface trail
 • Supplement woodland habitat
 • Work with Cleveland Public Library to develop trail link

Beachfront Walkway and Stormwater Improvements
 • Connect pier to Villa Angela with ADA All Purpose Trail on beach level
 • Pursue green infrastructure in parking area and improve beach outflow
 • Enhance plantings on bluff

Shelter and Picnic Area
 • Improve site circulation; upgrade lighting and site furnishings

Euclid Beach Midway
 • Continue to enhance core of Euclid Beach Park with plaza and overlook, placemaking features and site furnishings
 • Add lakefront pavilion for events and rentals. Consider glass, garage doors or wind screens
 • Develop play features with community partners, potentially including water play for days with poor conditions for swimming
 • Consider removing perimeter fence

Overlook with Bike Parking and Swing

New Pier Area Environment
 • Provide additional shoreline stabilization and plantings

Lakefront Connections
 • Pursue trail connections to East 156th and points west

Euclid Creek Connector, Cleveland Lakefront Bikeway and Lake Erie Coastal Ohio Trail
 • Continue to improve bicycle and pedestrian connections to the lakefront
 • Link to main portion of Euclid Creek Reservation
 • Monitor neighboring parcels and partnering opportunities

Wildwood Park
- Concession and Marina
 • Remove excess pavement, replace as needed to meet accessibility requirements
 • Upgrade site furnishings and landscape
- Parking
 • Reconfigure east lot and reduce paving
 • Reduced mowed areas
- Shelter
 • Add single unit CXT near shelter

Euclid Creek
 • Continue to work with watershed group for upstream protection
 • Add natural surface trail near oxbow
