





Bikes: Free bike self-parking racks provided by Ohio City Bicycle Co-Op (remember to bring your own lock and park at your own risk!) A Slow Roll will leave from the Marquette gate on Saturday at 2 pm and return to the 53rd Street gate at 4 pm.

Sustainability: Recycling and composting in partnership with Rust Belt Riders are provided throughout the site. Styrofoam is prohibited. In an effort to reduce plastic waste, Ingenuity and Cleveland Water are providing free water to site and sales of reusable water bottles - or bring your own!

Parking, Rideshare: Street parking is available on many side streets, or in a dedicated lot at 5000 Lakeside (\$5). Pickup/Dropoff at 53rd Street gate.

Accessible Services: ADA parking & golf cart drop off to gate available.

Information & Medical: Medical tent and EMS pickup at 53rd street gate. Info and first aid at both gates.






